Wear Your Wellbeing Day

Invite children to dress in a colour that reflects their mood or to choose an outfit that shows how they like to look after their wellbeing - sports gear, PJs or dancewear - let them 'wear their wellbeing'. Find a poster for a "Wear Your Wellbeing Day" day **here**

Guessing Games

Fill a jar with sweets and ask students to guess how many sweets are in the jar, the nearest guess wins the treats!

Or buy a Teddy bear, name it and ask students to guess the name. The person who gets it right wins the bear and a prize! Students can donate £1 for entry into the competition.




Parents Night

You could host a trivia night, a wine and cheese night or a jazz night. Anything that gives parents the opportunity to come together, enjoy themselves and help by raising some funds, is great.

Art with a Heart

Give students time to be creative by asking them to design and produce a piece of art work.

You can then make the designs available for parents to buy.

Arts and Crafts Evening

Invite some of your stakeholders, networks and local businesses to the school, provide them with supplies and get creative!
You could follow a painting tutorial from an Art Teacher, or create some jewellery or paint some pottery in the D&T Lab.

This is also a great opportunity for pupils and staff to creatively express themselves.





Sponsorship

Ask your pupils, teachers or parents to take part in an individual sponsored event or a challenge of their choice. Will you do a sponsored silence? a fun run? a skydive?

The choice is yours!

Jumble Sale

Ask for donations for any old clothes, knick-knacks or gifts your pupils and parents haven't used and sell them to raise money for Kids Inspire.

You could set up an online shop or run a car boot sale during lunchtime.





Afternoon Tea

Host an Afternoon Tea at School Lunch Time! Invite your pupils' parents over for a lunch time treat of tea, cakes and raising vital funds for Kids Inspire.

You could ask guests to donate money for their "ticket."
